Seventy years ago Lou Gehrig gave his farewell speech to his team and fans. Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), a fatal progressive neurodegenerative disease, took away his ability to play baseball and eventually his life. Each year over 5,600 people are diagnosed with ALS. Each day, walking and speaking become more difficult. Muscles weaken and we are no longer able to carry on a normal life or normal conversation with someone. I am asking you to help me raise money to help support the Rocky Mountain ALS Chapter. They provide ALS patients with services such as in-home visits, education materials, and durable medical equipment - like walkers and wheelchairs. Your donation will also help fund research for the cure. I realize our current economy is not the greatest and we need to make every dollar count.
