Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), a fatal progressive neurodegenerative disease, took away his ability to play baseball and eventually his life. Each year over 5,600 people are diagnosed with ALS. Each day, walking and speaking become more difficult. Muscles weaken and we are no longer able to carry on a normal life or normal conversation with someone.

I was diagnosed with Primary Lateral Sclerosis (PLS), which is a rare form of ALS that progresses much slower.
