**LUTHERAN INSIGHT**

“The **Lutheran insight** is that there is no moral or spiritual reform for the old being. Christianity is no program for moral rearmament, even in the face of our pressing moral needs. The old being, in truth, cannot be recycled. The old being can only be brought to an end: die. And, the Christian life shares in this death (the wages of sin) by which God is bringing down all old beings, whether they be Christian or not. The good news is that God in Christ is raising the dead, allowing new beings to emerge who live by faith, and through faith honor God's deity as truth, beauty, and goodness, and, as beings set free from their self-legitimizing, self-centered ways, are able to begin to care for their neighbors, often from the heart.”
